Weed of the Month

Tree (Pine) Echium

ID Tips:

- Purple or blue 5-petal flower
- Can grow up to 15' in height
- Biennial - rosette in 1st yr, flowering 2nd yr then dies back
- Bloom time: May - August



WARNING: Hairs on their stems can cause blistering when touched.

Tree echium thrives in well drained soils. It's dense 2' - 3' wide rosettes will shade out native plants in your yard and create a monoculture; eventually displacing any smaller plants you have planted.

It is a self-seeding plant, meaning it's seed will germinate just weeks after being shed - so you can imagine how quickly it will dominate your yard!
